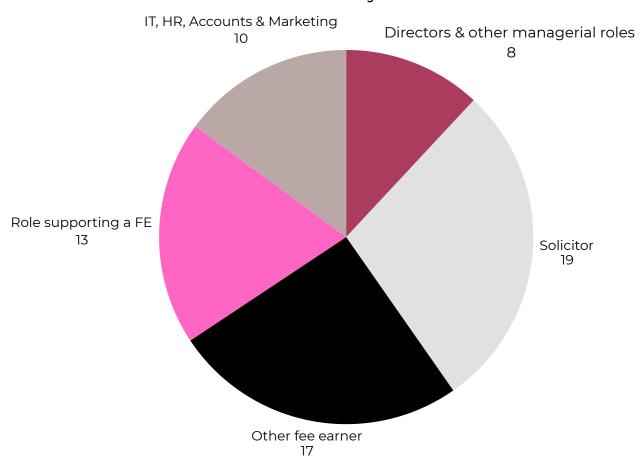

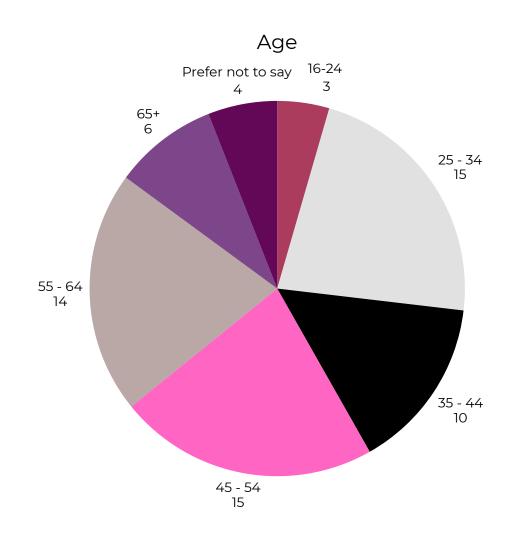
# Breakdown of staff completing the survey



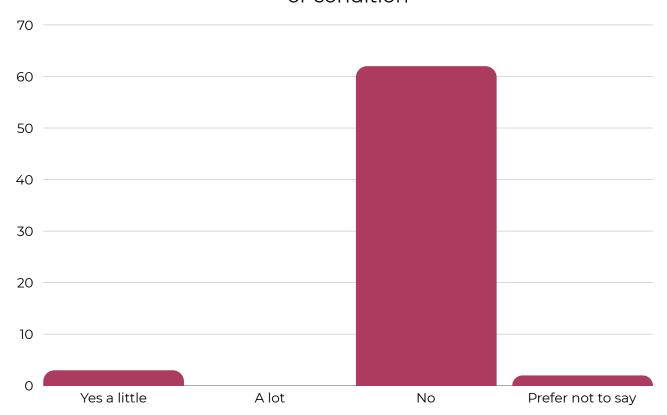


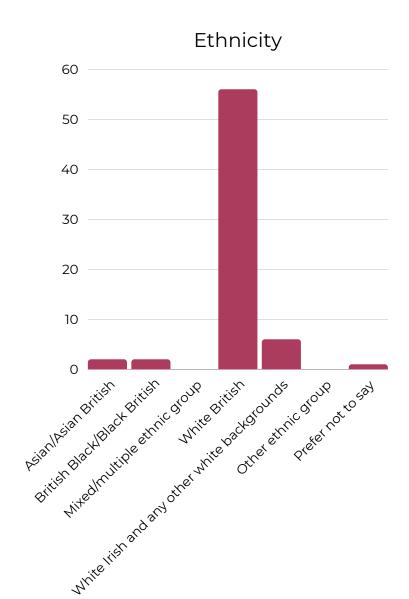


Gender identity the same as at birth = 66/67 with 1/67 = Prefer not to say

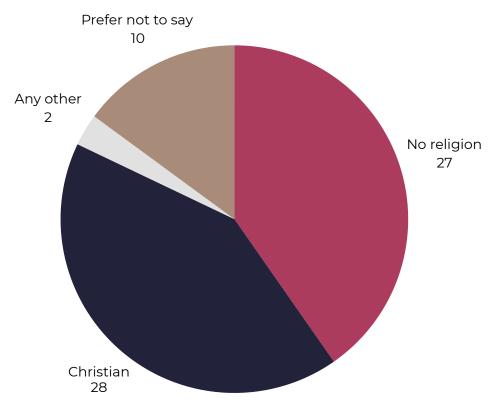


### Reported limitations in day-to-day activities due to disability or condition

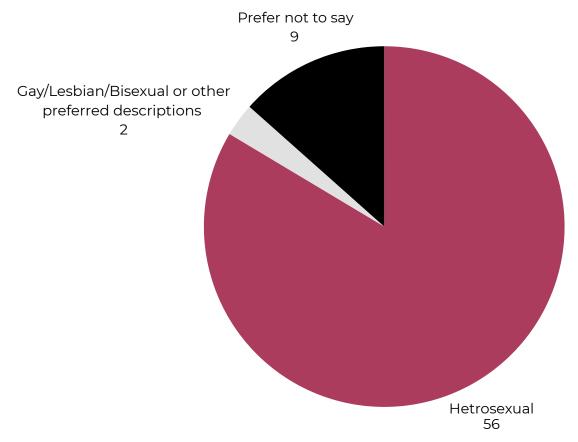




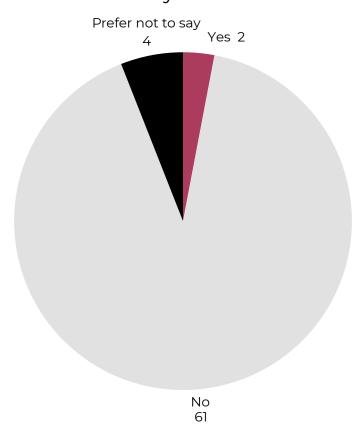
#### Religion or belief



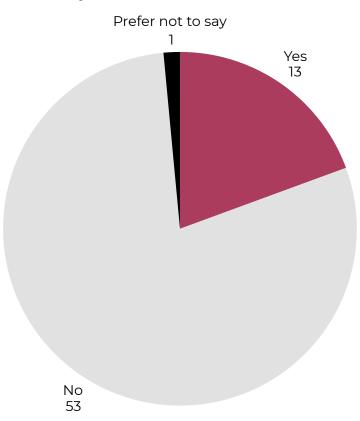

# Carer for someone over the age of 18 years old



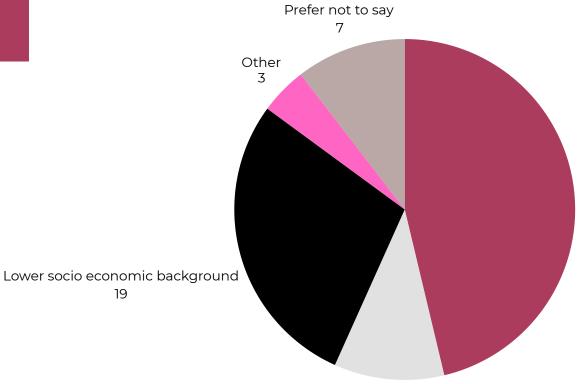
#### Primary carer for a child under 18

# Occupation of main household earner when 14 years old

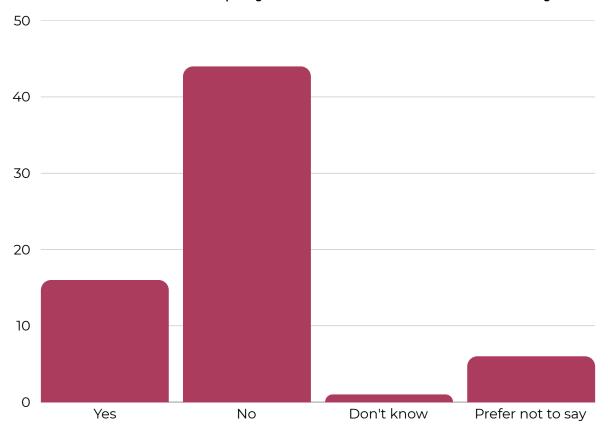
